- Spanish 1 is a one-year high school credit course. Upon successful completion, students will receive a 1.0 high school credit.
- Your child's final grade in this course is based on the average of the six six-weeks' grades plus the spring semester final exam. To calculate your child's overall grade for the course, you add the six six-weeks' averages and the spring semester final, then divide by seven.
- The grade for this course will transfer to high school and be included in your child's high school grade point average (GPA) calculation. It will count toward your child's high school class rank.
